She brought with her a tiny mouse.
(Head moves in and out like an emu)

V7 Oh my Aunt came back from Hobart
She brought with her a cherry tart
(Tongue sticks out)

V8 Oh my Aunt came back from the Melbourne Zoo
She brought with her a monkey like you!
(Stop everything and point to somebody else)
