 - * Sing the 'Ah-choo' section in unison
 - * Sing the Ah-Choo and Anteater sections as a partner song
 - * Repeat, swapping parts
 - * Sing the Anteater section speeding up.....and then
 - * Finish with a loud Ah-choo!
